#### 4. Public Participation-

#### 7. The Holme Play Area

Sovereign Play has installed the new agility trail. There are however, a number of issues to be rectified. 2 Wobbly posts, missing components, splits in the timber, sap seeping from the timber and concerns that the metal feet, installed for protection of timber, do not surround the posts. Sovereign has been advised.

# 8. Update on installation of CCTV cameras

The cameras have been installed on the White Hart and the other will be installed on Maesbury at the bottom of Wesley St over the next couple of weeks. Once the cameras are up the paperwork needs finalizing and the software will be shared with the nominated councillors.

9. Consideration was given to signage at the top of Wesley Street to warn road users of pedestrians In the first instance it was agreed some vegetation clearance on the left hand side may improve the visibility on the bend for drivers and give pedestrians more space to walk.

## 10. Highway Safety Issues

A number of issues have been raised by residents-

A recent accident in which a resident was knocked down on Clitheroe Road highlighted parking issues in the vicinity of Top Row

Car wing mirrors are being knocked off on Padiham Road due to road width when vehicles are parking inappropriately

Width of pavement- very narrow- on Clitheroe Road makes it difficult for Wheel chair users and those with prams/buggys

Speed of traffic driving over Pendle.

Residents will be encouraged to use Lancashire Police online reporting system for non urgent issues i.e. wing mirror incidents

The Traffic & Road Safety Working group is canvassing for 20mph gateways
